Dear Algae-x:

I wish to thank you for your excellent fuel cleaning product. I own a 55 foot catamaran and am in year 3 and 2/3 through a world circumnavigation. My catamaran "SOLMATES" is currently in Turkey, having sailed from Florida through the Panama Canal, South Seas, Australia, Indonesia, Thailand, Indian Ocean, Red Sea, and the eastern portion of the Mediterranean Ocean.

I have used Algae-X units on both of my 50 hp Yanmar engines with stunning results. Only out of habit do I replace my Racor fuel filters about every 12 months, but they are generally still reasonably clean in appearance and probably do not need replacement.

Importantly, however, the fuel line for my genset is "tee-d" off the port engine's diesel supply line immediately BEFORE the Algae-X cleaner. The Racor fuel filter and two other in-line fuel filters to the genset too frequently and irritatingly have been repeatedly clogged by what appears to be black algae from the fuel tank. Clearly the Algae-X is doing a fantastic job since the port engine has never had a clogged filter but the genset's filter bank supplied from the same fuel line yet unaided by the Algae-X is frequently affected by fuel contamination. I have recently purchased from you a third Algae-X unit for installation on the supply line for the genset; I am confident this will terminate the continual clogging of the genset fuel filters.

Thanks, again, for a great product!
